

Ski Season 2015 Plans Taking Shape!

The ski season for 2014-5 is starting to take shape! Two OVSC trips have been organized: Whistler/Blackcomb and Jackson Hole. We will be going to Whistler/Blackcomb, British Columbia, January 24-31. We will be staying in two bedroom condos in the Tantalus Lodge in Whistler Village. From February 21-28, we will go to Jackson Hole, Wyoming, and stay in the Rendevous Condos in Teton Village. These condos are ski-in and adjacent to the Sundance Tennis & Swim Club with outdoor pool and jacuzzi.

In addition, the board just approved a trip to Keystone, Colorado from February 7-14. We will be staying at the Evergreen Condos. This trip includes a five day interchangeable lift ticket valid at Keystone and Arapahoe Basin with an option to ski two of the days at Breckenridge, Vail, or Beaver Creek. The pricing and options on this trip are outstanding. Details later!

The European trip this winter will be to Madonna di Campiglio, Italy from March 6-13. Optional extensions are planned to Milan (March 13-15), Ireland (March 15-22), and Scotland (March 22-25).
