

LSSC - OVSC TRIP TO EUROPE

MARCH 11-27 2016

This year's Europe trip took place March 11-27 and was organized by the OVSC. Only two clubs, Lexington and Dayton participated, resulting in a lower than normal group of 18. Skiers from Cincinnati and Louisville joined the trip by registering with Lexington.

Trip Leader Janet Jones was unable to participate due to emergency surgery and a lengthy hospitalization right before the trip was scheduled to leave. Fortunately, she has recovered and returned to work. Dan Geiger filled in for Janet as Trip Leader.

The first stop was skiing in Solden, Austria. We spent seven nights in the beautiful Hotel Tyrolerhof, enjoying a fabulous breakfast and dinner buffet each day. The hotel was on the main street in the ski town of Solden, two blocks from the gondola. The street was lined with ski shops, hotels, restaurants and bars. We enjoyed walking around town after skiing to shop and enjoy after ski drinks in the local bars.

The skiing was terrific. Snow conditions were superb (packed powder) and the weather was generally sunny with ideal temperatures (25-35F). The ski area was mammoth. We liked to ski the glacier which was 1.5 hours ski time each way from our gondola. At the top of the second gondola was an ultra modern glass restaurant called the Ice Cube where we enjoyed drinks and lunch. The Ice Cube appears in several scenes in the recent James Bond movie Spectre.

At the end of the first week some skiers went home and others flew to Athens, Greece for the second leg of the trip. The plan was to take a high speed ferry (5 hours) to the island of Mykonos, then board a cruise ship for 3 nights, disembarking at the island of Santorini and returning to Athens by high speed ferry. High winds and rough seas prevented the boat from unloading passengers at two islands.

As a result, we missed the islands of Patmos and Santorini. We did spend time on gorgeous Mykonos and visit historic Kusadasi on mainland Turkey. The upside of the change in plans was two full days in Athens where we saw the Acropolis and Parthenon as well as the stunning new Acropolis Museum and Greek Antiquities Museum.

The amazing thing about Greece is you are seeing and touching buildings and artifacts 2500 years old from a sophisticated culture that established the principles of rule of law and democratic government by the people.

We learned to use the Athens subway and rode around like locals. Greek pastries are to die for. Athens beggars seemed to be able to pick out tourists and we were approached occasionally.

By any measure a great trip!!
