**Summit Registration:**

This year's OVSC Summit is hosted by the Indianapolis Ski Club and will be held June 3-5, 2011. The deadline to register is May 28th. You can register online at [ovsc.org](http://ovsc.org).

Summit registration is \$49 which includes all weekend activities except for golf or special tours. The Saturday night dinner cost is included in the \$49 fee. Additional fees and payment options are noted below:

- ❖ Friday Golf Outing: Cost \$50 payable with Summit registration.
- ❖ Saturday Tour of Indianapolis Motor Speedway: Cost \$10 payable at the time of the tour.
- ❖ Saturday NCAA Hall of Fame: Cost \$5 payable at the door.
- ❖ Saturday Dinner and Entertainment: Cost \$35 if not attending Summit

You may register online for the Summit and/or individual activities. Online registration will allow for online payment or for a check to be mailed. If mailing a check after registering online, you do NOT need to fill out a paper registration form. Simply mail the check as directed on your confirmation.
